



Examination Department Annual Report - 2023-24

The Convocation of the University is a significant event, celebrating the academic achievements of graduating students and marking an important institutional milestone. It expands the alumni network, fosters a sense of pride, and inspires future students. The event also highlights the university's commitment to research, innovation, and academic excellence, strengthening its reputation and engagement with the community and industry.

To ensure the smooth and successful conduct of the 7th Convocation Ceremony, Hon'ble Dr. Mangesh Karad, Executive President and Vice-Chancellor, had appointed Prof. Dr. Anant Chakradeo, Pro-Vice Chancellor, as Chief Convener, and Dr. Ramachandra Pujeri, Pro-Vice Chancellor, as Chairman. Various committees and their chief coordinators were designated to manage the event's preparations.

The 7th Convocation was held on **23 September 2024** at **03:00 P.M.** at "**Bharat Ratna Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Mandapam,**" next to the World Peace Dome, Vishwarajbaug, MIT ADT University Campus, Loni Kalbhor, Pune. Hon'ble Governor of Maharashtra Shri. C. P. Radhakrishnan, was present as the Chief Guest and delivered the convocation address.

Hon'ble Shri. M. Sankaran, Director and Distinguished Scientist (ISRO), was the Guest of Honour and addressed the gathering. The convocation ceremony was presided over by Hon'ble Prof. Dr. Vishwanath D. Karad, President of MIT ADT University, Pune, who delivered the Presidential Address. Hon'ble Prof. Dr. Mangesh T. Karad, Executive President and Vice-Chancellor, delivered the welcome address and guided the graduates.

Hon'ble Prof. Dr. Anant Chakradeo, Pro-Vice Chancellor, presented the application to the Hon'ble President on behalf of all the Deans of the faculties.

During the ceremony, **53** Gold Medals, **194** Rank Certificates along with UG, PG Degrees for a total of **2710** regular students, and **22** Ph.D. degrees were conferred.
