Accessibility Features at MIT ADT University:

Ramps and Lifts: The university provides accessible ramps and lifts across campus to ensure ease of movement for disabled individuals. Ramps are designed with a gentle incline, and lifts have wide doors and ample space for wheelchairs. Wheelchairs are strategically placed near ramps for independent or assisted use.

Disabled-Friendly Washrooms: Most campus buildings feature washrooms equipped with accessibility features like grab bars, adhering to standard specifications for disabled individuals.

Sign Boards: Signboards placed throughout the campus assist disabled students in navigating the university easily and independently.

Assistive Technology: Screen-reading software and other assistive technologies are available on the university website to support the technical development of differently-abled persons.

Provision for Assistance: Human assistance, scribe support, and other accommodations are available, in accordance with Government of India guidelines, to ensure fair access during exams and daily activities.
